UC Berkeley Anthropology Museum Granada Egyptian Tour

Twenty-five of us attended the exhibition at the University of California at Berkeley, **The Conservator's Art: "Preserving Egypt's Past,"** Allison Lewis, a Samuel H. Kress Conservation Fellow, was working on Egyptian artifacts in the gallery so she was available to answer questions and explained conservation methods and techniques. The Museum was founded in 1901 by Phoebe Apperson Hearst, a visionary who saw the Hearst as the cultural cornerstone of one of the world's leading research institutions. Today, the Hearst houses the oldest and largest anthropological collection in the Western U.S., preserving and interpreting a global record of material culture as represented by more than 3.8 million catalogued objects. The Museum aims to promote the history and diversity of human cultures through research, education, exhibitions, and public programs. We explored the results of extensive conservation carried out on pieces including crocodile mummies, statuary, mummy, portraits, and amulets collected. After the Egyptian exhibit, we boarded our coach and headed for the hills, the Berkeley hills to the Lawrence Hall of Science and a breath taking view of our entire bay and some cold white wine and some red too. A beautiful day and a beautiful way to go, all part of the Granada's activities program which is free to all our residents, so plan to come out on our next tour and let Kevin, our activities director, show you around the bay.

AARP Free Income Tax returns \$\$\$

Well I did it! I saved \$\$\$ on my Federal Income Tax return. How? I had AARP do my returns for free! You don't have to be a member just over 55 or low income. Trained community volunteers help with special credits, such as Earned Income Tax Credit and Credit for the Elderly or the Disabled. In addition to free tax return preparation assistance, the site also offers free electronic filing (e-filing). Individuals taking advantage of the e-file program will receive their refunds in half the time compared to returns filed on paper – even faster when tax refunds are deposited directly into one's bank account So you can do it too, here's how. Bring:

- ✓ **Proof of identification**
- ✓ **Social Security Cards**
- ✓ **Birth dates for you, your spouse and dependents on the tax return**
- ✓ **Wage and earning statement(s) Form W-2, W-2G, 1099-R, from all employers**
- ✓ **Interest and dividend statements from banks (Forms 1099)**
- ✓ **A copy of last year's federal and state returns if available**
- ✓ **Proof of bank account routing numbers and account numbers for Direct Deposit, such as a blank check**
